After signing up, **you will receive an email with tickets confirming your seats.** Please print these tickets and bring them to your scheduled Mass. An usher will collect your ticket at the door. If you are unable to print your ticket at home, please call the parish office to have your ticket printed and available for pickup.

Volunteers for the 4:00, 6:00, & 8:00 p.m. Christmas Eve Masses will have early access to the Christmas Eve Mass tickets. If you sign up to volunteer, please call the parish office during office hours to confirm the number of seats you'd like to reserve. Volunteer tickets will be available starting November 23rd. Please note that reserving tickets does not guarantee you a seat in the church. Overflow seating will be set up in Marian Hall where the Mass will be live streamed. Ushers will direct those seated in Marian Hall during Communion.

As many of you know, our Christmas Eve 4:00 p.m. is our most popular Christmas Mass. If you usually come to this Mass, but have a flexible holiday schedule, we encourage you to consider attending another Mass. Thank you! We look forward to celebrating with you!

RESPECT LIFE CORNER

Over the next two months the Respect Life corner will focus on excerpts from St. Pope John Paul II's encyclical, *Veritatis Splendor*. To better grasp the beauty of this encyclical all are encouraged to read it in its entirety. 34. "Teacher, what good must I do to have eternal life?". The question of morality, to which Christ provides the answer, cannot prescind from the issue of freedom. Indeed, it considers that issue central, for there can be no morality without freedom: "It is only in freedom that man can turn to what is good".⁵⁶ But what sort of freedom? The Council, considering our contemporaries who "highly regard" freedom and "assiduously pursue" it, but who "often cultivate it in wrong ways as a licence to do anything they please, even evil", speaks of "genuine" freedom: "Genuine freedom is an outstanding manifestation of the divine image in man. For God willed to leave man "in the power of his own counsel" (cf. Sir 15:14), so that he would seek his Creator of his own accord and would freely arrive at full and blessed perfection by cleaving to God".⁵⁷ Although each individual has a right to be respected in his own journey in search of the truth, there exists a prior moral obligation, and a grave one at that, to seek the truth and to adhere to it once it is known.⁵⁸ As Cardinal John Henry Newman, that outstanding defender of the rights of conscience, forcefully put it: "Conscience has rights because it has duties".⁵⁹ John Paul II. *Veritatis Splendor* (#34). 6 August 1993. http://www.vatican.va/content/john-paul-ii/en/encyclicals/documents/hf_jp-ii_enc_06081993_veritatis-splendor.html
