


AROUND THE PARISH

During the month of January our Parish Faith Formation Families are diving into the life of Jesus and the Sacrament of Baptism. In every month of learning so far, we've seen a consistent pattern to the relationship between God and humanity: first, God comes to us. Then, hopefully, we go to God. In the Gospels we can see what it was actually like for God to become man. In other words, we can see what it looked like for God to live a human life. As Christians, we can respond to God's initiative through the Sacrament of Baptism. This answers the question to how we as humans can begin to live a divine life.

Let's respond to God's initiative this month by taking one step further in our prayer life together as a community. If the next step is going to a daily mass, then do it. If the next step is visiting our Adoration Chapel, then commit to it. If the next step is simply reading Scripture for 5 minutes, then begin. (It's never too late!) A specific way that we can join in prayer together is by remembering the Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of the Unborn on this upcoming Friday. January 22nd is the anniversary of the 1973 Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision that struck down abortion restrictions in all fifty states. Let us join together as a parish community to observe January 22nd through penitential practices of prayer, fasting, and giving Alms.

75TH ANNIVERSARY "DID YOU KNOW" – THE BUILDINGS:

First Building on property – Chase Mansion (on what was called Chase Farm). Built in 1817 and existed when the property for our church was purchased. Built by Bishop Philander Chase, First rector of St. John's Episcopal Church in Worthington and in 1818 was elected Bishop of the newly organized Episcopal Diocese of Ohio. Bishop Chase initially founded Kenyon College (now located in Gambier, Ohio) in what was formerly the Chase Mansion (current St. Michael's property). 
