

DEAR PARISHIONERS,

Lent is coming quickly. Here are some items of interest:

Ash Wednesday will be on February 17th. Public Mass Times for that day will be at 6:30am, 12:00 noon and 7:00 p.m.

While the Bishop had continued the dispensation for the faithful from their Sunday Obligation, the disciplines for "The Days of Abstinence and Fasting" during Lent and the Sacred Triduum still apply. The requirements are:

Abstinence – Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence. The Law of Abstinence binds all those who have completed their 14th year of age and older. On those days these faithful are not to eat meat.

Fasting – Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting. The Law of Fasting binds all from the age of 18 through the end of the 59th year. The Law of Fasting prescribes that only one full meal a day be taken. Two lighter meals are permitted but combined should not be more than one full meal.

Stations of the Cross will be prayed as usual on Fridays during Lent beginning at 7:30p.m.

- Saturday's 2:30-3:30pm, or anytime by appointment
- Fridays during Lent after Stations of the Cross
- Saturday March 13 during the parish observance the 40 Days of Adoration (See bulletin and Website for more information.
- March 29 Monday of Holy Week 7:00-9:00 p.m.
- March 31 Wednesday of Holy Week 7:00-9:00 p.m.
- April 1 Holy Thursday after the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper (begins at 7:00 p.m.).
- April 2 Good Friday after the 3:00pm Good Friday Liturgy and after the Stations of the Cross (Stations begin at 7:00 p.m.)

Sacred Triduum Liturgies:

- April 1st Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 p.m. with Adoration afterward until Midnight (Location TBA).
- April 2nd Good Friday Liturgy at 3:00 p.m.
- April 3rd Easter Vigil Mass 8:30 p.m.
- April 4th Masses at 8:30 a.m., 10:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m.

75TH ANNIVERSARY "DID YOU KNOW" - THE BUILDINGS:

St. Michael's second parish-owned church: Quonset Hut

July 11, 1948: Dedicated with Pontifical Low Mass Location in black and white aerial photo: Long structure, top of photo

Quonset hut (GI style military barrack) stretched north to south along the east end of our parking lot where the hill to the baseball field begins and where the basketball hoops are. The Quonset hut had the church on the south end (near Selby Blvd.), gymnasium in the center and classrooms in the north end (near playground).



Current church: • September 30, 1962: Ground Breaking

• May 14, 1964: Cornerstone laid

- June 12, 1964: First Mass for Grade School Graduation
- June 14, 1964: First Sunday Mass
- August 27, 1964: Dedication

Also in color aerial photos: The Cornerstone lies at the foot of the huge stone arch through which the sanctuary extends into the apse, on the Gospel side (next to the Ambo). It houses a metal box containing a list of 1962 parishioners; the 1962 parish financial report; pictures of Pope John XXIII, Bishop Issenmann and Bishop Ready; a list of officers of parish organizations; copies of the Catholic Times, the Citizen-Journal and the Worthington News; coins of the years 1947 and 1962; a bottle of Lourdes water, and a statue of the Infant of Prague.


The total cost to build our current church was \$636,000, which included furnishings and fees. At the time of dedication 806 persons could be seated in the church at one time. Today, it is around 770.

RESPECT LIFE CORNER

During the month of January we remember the tragic decision of Roe v. Wade, which legalized abortion based on a woman's constitutional right to privacy. To better understand the teachings of the Catholic Church in regard to abortion, the Respect Life Corner will feature excerpts from Dignitas Personae."4. In recent decades, medical science has made significant strides in understanding human life in its initial stages. Human biological structures and the process of human generation are better known. These developments are certainly positive and worthy of support when they serve to overcome or correct pathologies and succeed in re-establishing the normal functioning of human procreation. On the other hand, they are negative and cannot be utilized when they involve the destruction of human beings or when they employ means which contradict the dignity of the person or when they are used for purposes contrary to the integral good of man. The body of a human being, from the very first stages of its existence, can never be reduced merely to a group of cells. The embryonic human body develops progressively according to a well-defined program with its proper finality, as is apparent in the birth of every baby.

It is appropriate to recall the fundamental ethical criterion expressed in the Instruction Donum vitae in order to evaluate all moral questions which relate to procedures involving the human embryo: "Thus the fruit of human generation, from the first moment of its existence, that is to say, from the moment the zygote has formed, demands the unconditional respect that is morally due to the human being in his bodily and spiritual totality. The human being is to be respected and treated as a person from the moment of conception; and therefore from that same moment his rights as a person must be recognized, among which in the first place is the inviolable right of every innocent human being to life".[6]"




