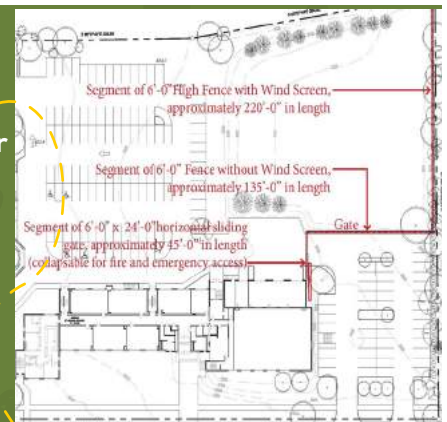
St. Michael Fence & Gate Project
