As has been announced, our Parochial Vicar Fr. Herge has been appointed pastor of the Jackson-Vinton County Consortium of Parishes and will begin there on July 13th. Information will be forthcoming on opportunities to send him off with our prayers! As of now, I have not heard as to whether we will be receiving a priest in his stead. If and when I do, I will let you all know as soon as I am instructed.

At the Parish Pastoral Council meeting this week, I updated the members on the process of the lifting of the COVID-19 pandemic requirements. Organizations seeking the use of the parish facilities should check with their representatives as to what can be done and when. The Bishop has reminded us that masks should be worn in the parish buildings until the lifting of the mandate by the State of Ohio.

We are moving forward in planning for a full festival this Labor Day Weekend. Information on how you can participate will be provided soon!

Also remember to pray for the three transitional deacons who will be ordained to the priesthood for the Diocese of Columbus on May 29th. Those to be ordained are: Rev. Dcn. Stephen Ondrey, Rev. Dcn. Eugene Joseph and Rev. Dcn. Jacob Stinnett. May God bless them!
