

As has been announced, our Parochial Vicar Fr. Herge has been appointed pastor of the Jackson-Vinton County Consortium of Parishes and will begin there on July 13th. If and when I do, I will let you all know as soon as I am instructed.

The Bishop has reminded us that masks should be worn in the parish buildings until the lifting of the mandate by the State of Ohio.


