



## Disciple Maker Index Survey

St. Michael Parish Results

Your Feedback on the DMI Survey Provides Valuable Information for

St. Michael Parish

This past spring our parish had the opportunity to participate in the Disciple Maker Index (DMI) survey. About 33 percent of parishioners took the opportunity to give their feedback. The national participation average is between 7-10 percent, so this puts St. Michael above the national average.

The Disciple Maker Index contained 75 questions designed to provide an opportunity for parishioners to reflect on their individual spiritual growth and overall parish effectiveness. Almost 300,000 Catholics from more than 1,500 parishes throughout 40 dioceses have taken the DMI since 2013, providing not just valuable data for each parish, but for the Church nationally as well.

Of the 336 surveys that were completed, 318 were done online and 18 completed on paper at the parish. The majority of respondents were women, representing 60 percent of the total respondents.





# Key Findings

### St. Michael Strengths

### Attitudes and Beliefs

- 79% strongly believe in the True Presence of the Eucharist, compared to 71% nationally and 74% in our diocese.
- 80% strongly believe that Scripture is the Word of God, compared to 69% nationally and 73% in our diocese.
- 85% attend Mass at least weekly and 70% pray daily.

**Potential Action Step:** Identify which of these strengths align with the following opportunities for growth and could be a starting point for future efforts.

### St. Michael Opportunities for Growth

### Sharing the faith with others

- Our lowest 3 rankings were:
  - 1. Sharing personal story
  - 2. Sharing the story of Jesus
  - 3. Explaining Church teachings
- 46% never invite someone to come to Mass, compared to 33% nationally and 38% in our diocese.

**Potential Action Step:** Identify the role of a personal witness story and plan how to explain and train for discipleship.

### Helping Spiritual Growth of Parishioners

- 27% strongly agree that the parish helps their spiritual growth, compared to 38% nationally and 35% in our diocese.
- Our least frequent spiritual practices were:
  - 1. Spiritual direction / pastoral counseling
  - 2. Attending a retreat

**Potential Action Step:** Plan ways to encourage faith mentor relationships, retreat attendance & catechesis opportunities.







### 75TH ANNIVERSARY: PARISH HISTORY

### The Reverend John P. Byrne, Founding Pastor of St. Michael Church

Under his guidance and timeless effort, this beloved man of Irish heritage has left a legacy under which the church, the parish and community of life has flourished since the founding of our parish. He was named pastor emeritus in November of 1977 during a Mass and reception by parishioners on Father Byrne's 75th birthday.

"I give you this honor in view of your long years of devoted priestly ministry to the people in the Worthington area".... Bishop Edward J. Hermann

An avid fisherman and a crowd pleaser at informal functions with his Irish renditions on the harmonica, Father Byrne was born October 22, 1902 in Glynwood, Ohio. Ordained for the Cincinnati archdiocese May 30, 1931, in St. Peter Cathedral by Archbishop John McNicholas, he served as assistant priest in Hamilton and Cincinnati parishes. He also taught at Cincinnati Roger Bacon High School prior to being named chaplain of the old Chillicothe Federal Reformatory in 1939.

In a realignment of diocesan boundaries in 1944, Chillicothe was merged with Columbus and Father Byrne became a priest of the Columbus Diocese. At that time Father Byrne's knowledge of Worthington was relatively minor although he had visited the Josephinium Pontifical Seminary along Rt. 23 just north of the city. In a meeting with Bishop Ready, he was given the choice of establishing two different parishes in the Columbus area. One of them was Worthington. He chose Worthington. The date was January 31, 1946.

A graduate of St. Joseph College, Collegeville, Indiana, Maxima Cum Laude, Father Byrne pursued further studies at St. Gregory Seminary of the West, Norwood, Ohio. He had resided at St. Charles Seminary, Carthagena, Ohio since his retirement in 1976. In May 1991, a Mass and receptions was held at St. Michael honoring Father Byrnes's 60 years as a priest. He died August 1, 1994 at the age of 91 following complications from a stroke. A special funeral Mass was held August 4, 1994 in St. Michael for family, friends and parishioners, who came to honor and pay homage to their founding pastor. The most Reverend James A. Griffin, Bishop of the Columbus Diocese, officiated at the Mass.
