



# ST. MICHAEL STORY: IN THE BEGINNING CONTINUED... PART 3

Although progress had been made in the new parish and attendance was on the increase, Father Byrne's main concern was finding a permanent site for a church. In his daily searching for possible locations within the City of Worthington, he noticed a vacant piece of land on the east side of N. High St. immediately north of Selby boulevard, abutting a large white house.

With this information, the hard-working priest once again met with Bishop Ready to apprise him of his findings. Father Byrne found acquiring the land and the big white house, known as the Chase Mansion, was not that easy. He learned that the Chase Mansion had been sold to Gaylord "Pete" Stinchomb, an All-American fullback at Ohio State University during the football career of the famous Chic Harley.

By April 1946, both the land parcel and the Chase Mansion were purchased for \$5,500 with money loaned by the diocese. The total land purchase was just under 6 acres with a frontage of 450 ft. on N. High St. Soon, the stately old mansion was converted into a combination church, school and rectory.




