

#### DEAR PARISHIONERS,

With the arrival of Fr. Emmanuel Adu Addai on August 17th, the Mass times for St. Michael Parish will be as follows effective Wednesday, August 18th:

I am excited to announce that we are partnering this year with the Damascus Catholic Youth Summer Camp and their Parish Youth Ministry Program. In this partnership, we will have a team of Damascus missionaries on scheduled youth ministry nights to facilitate a program similar to a night of Club at Catholic Youth Summer Camp. These evenings will consist of Praise & Worship, a dynamic message focused on prayer, mission, Church teaching and discipleship, as well as a time of small group processing. The first main event will take place on Sunday, October 3rd here at St. Michael. Information will be sent soon, so please be on the lookout! Let's go St. Michael!

As you all know, we have exceeded our parish goal for this year's Bishop's Annual Appeal (BAA). As of the writing of this update, we are currently \$19,573.00 over the goal, which will come back to us for our own use. As was announced at the beginning, we will use this money towards a flooring project in the main Church to remove the tiles from beneath the church pews and replace them with new tiles. Also, we will be stripping the wax from the slate flooring. The total of this project is expected to be about \$57,000.00. There is still time to give to the Bishop's Annual Appeal to help support this project. Remember that the money we receive back from the BAA comes to us free of the 6% Diocesan Assessment on income. # ST. MICHAEL STORY: IN THE BEGINNING CONTINUED ... PART 4

The parish continued to grow. A fundraising campaign brought a new school building to fruition in 1954. The new structure housed 11 classrooms, cafeteria and kitchen. It provided breathing space for Father Byrne and his growing parish, nearly doubling in size. By 1956, the parish witnessed further growth to nearly 400 families and more than 1,500 individuals. Further help came for Father Byrne when Father John M. Fulcher, a newly ordained diocesan priest, was appointed St. Michael's first full-time assistant pastor.

There was concern, however, by the new parishioners that it would take many years before a new church could be built. Some, like present parishioner, Paul Cotter, surmised, they would never see it in their lifetime. None could have visualized the beautiful new church, and other buildings that would soon make up the St. Michael parish grounds.

A new church had to come sooner or later. It was only a question of "when." Plans for a new church were being prepared by local architect Edward Ramsey, a St. Michael parishioner, who had prepared the plans for the school and rectory. Estimated cost of the new church was roughly \$500,000.00. Additional funding of \$125,000.00 was proposed for a new convent for the Joliet Franciscan sisters to replace the 150-year-old Chase Mansion which had been used as the convent since the school had been built. Another \$10,000.00 was earmarked to remodel the Quonset for more school space.




