

DEAR PARISHIONERS,

I would like to encourage each parishioner to participate as you are able in the Diocesan Real Presence, Real Future Gathering on August 27th (Live Stream only) & 28th (Live Stream and In-person) You may register by going to the www.rprfgathering.com/. I am glad to report to you that, since my update last week we are currently \$31,673 over the BAA goal, which will come back to us for our own use. As was announced at the beginning, we will use this money towards a flooring project in the main Church to remove the tiles from beneath the church pews and replace them with new tiles. Also, we will be stripping the wax from the slate flooring. The total of this project is expected to be about \$57,000.00. There is still time to give to the Bishop's Annual Appeal to help support this project. Remember that the money we receive back from the BAA comes to us free of the 6% Diocesan Assessment on income. You may still pick up a BAA pledge envelope at the Church, or go to https://www.columbuscatholicgiving.org/baa and make your donation online. Please be sure to indicate St. Michael Parish as your parish. Thank you all for your generosity!

THE DOMINICAN SISTERS – PART 1

Happy 10th Anniversary to The Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist!

In 1967, a new convent was built for nine Joliet Franciscan Sisters who served the parish school and parish community with dedication for thirty years. From June 1974 until 2011 the parish was without the presence of any Sisters. On August 14, 2011 an open house was held for the Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist, who came down from Ann Arbor, Michigan at the invitation of Bishop Frederick Campbell to establish a Mission at St. Michaels. As the parish celebrates their 75th Anniversary, the Sisters celebrate their 10th Anniversary on August 14, 2021.

The Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist, an Ann Arbor based order of teaching sisters, had accepted the St Michael pastor's request to join St. Michael School. The sisters were to provide the school principal and four teaching sisters for the 2012 school year. They would occupy the Convent building, no longer the Vianney Home, and at the time called St. Ann Hall. In order for the Sisters to take occupancy of St. Ann Hall, a plan to remodel the inside of the building was planned, so that it would function as it once did when the Joliet Franciscan Sisters had been in residence. The remodel, largely overseen by Father Stash Dailey, Associate Pastor of St. Michael and friend of the Sisters, as well as volunteers from St. Michael and other nearby parishes would include; relocating the parish offices to a temporary trailer in the parish parking lot across from the Rectory garage, relocating the St. Vincent DePaul Pantry and storage room, relocating offices and storage rooms in the upper floors, and relocating the Divine Mercy Adoration Chapel to other locations around the parish plant, since the Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist required use of the entire facility to function as a Cloistered Convent community.


