



DEAR PARISHIONERS,

Our Parish Festival is just around the corner and is set for Labor Day Weekend. We are in need of many volunteers in order to make this a success. Please sign up today. As part of the ongoing strategic process for Real Presence, Real Future, the Diocese of Columbus will be hosting Consultation Sessions for each parish throughout the fall. Two sessions will be held via Zoom video-conferencing for each parish in the Diocese. Facilitators will guide parishioners through important statistical and sacramental information relevant to the Diocese as a whole, to parishes in surrounding areas, as well as individual parish information. Parishioner participation in these sessions is critical to helping shape the future of the Diocese of Columbus.

The Parish Consultation Sessions are a vital part of the planning process that encourages parishioners to offer insights and perspective on the future planning of their parish. The feedback provided during these sessions will be used to draft new models for review by parishioners in early 2022. The consultation process will continue throughout 2022 until final models are approved. No decisions have been made regarding any parish, and none will be made until feedback is gathered directly from parishioners through the consultation process. Dates and times will be announced soon, so please stay tuned!

I am glad to report to you that, since my update last week, we are currently \$38,890.00 over the BAA goal. We will use this money towards a flooring project in the main Church at a cost of about \$57,000.00. There is still time to give to the Bishop's Annual Appeal to help support this project. Remember that the money we receive back from the BAA comes to us free of the 6% Diocesan Assessment on income. Please be sure to indicate St. Michael Parish as your parish. Thank you all for your generosity!






