PARISH HISTORY

St. Michael Story continued... Part 6 ...Story contributor: Ron Eifert

In June 1974, the convent, which had been completed in 1967, was closed and the church saw the departure of the Joliet Franciscan sisters who had so diligently served the educational needs of the school and parish for three decades. The former convent was transferred to the Diocese of Columbus in October, 1974 and became a retirement home for priests called Vianney Residence.

By the spring of the following year, plans were underway to fund Our Lady of Lourdes Grotto. Campaign workers were jubilant when it was learned that they had reached their goal of \$5,000 to construct the shrine at the north end of the entrance drive near High Street. When our Lady of Lourdes Grotto was completed, the faculty and students of St. Michael Elementary School gathered on June 10, 1976, at the shrine. Father Byrne offered prayers and the Act of Solemn Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

1976 brought several clergy changes when our founding pastor Father Byrne reached retirement age after serving 30 years as pastor of St. Michael Parish. On October 31, 1976, this beloved man of Irish heritage, bade fond farewell to members of his church and their families.

With his departure, Bishop Herrmann announced on November 17, 1976 that co-pastors Fathers John A. Geiger and Robert E. Schneider were assigned to St. Michael. Formal installation of the new priests was celebrated three weeks later on December 5, 1976.

The parish now was more than 30 years old and faced with spiraling costs of inflation. It was becoming more difficult to carry out day-to-day activities and provide for capital expenses of the parish plant. Over the years, members of the parish have repeatedly volunteered their services to help St. Michael meet various obligations demanded by a growing parish. Working in cooperation with the priests and diocese, parishioners have become the bulwark of support, financial and otherwise. Their exceptional talents and dedication to the Church have brought a wealth of creativeness and

The Pio Cardinal Laghi Chair was inaugurated at the Josephinum in 1992 in honor of Pio Cardinal Laghi, then Prefect of the Congregation for Catholic Education. American cardinals and presidents of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops promoted the funding of this chair in recognition of Cardinal Laghi's dedicated service to the Catholic Church in the United States.

About Dr. Reyes: Prior to his current position with the Knights of Columbus, Dr. Reyes served as Assistant General Secretary for Integral Human Development and Executive Director of the Department of Justice, Peace and Human Development at the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. He came to the role from his work as President and CEO of Catholic Charities in the Archdiocese of Denver. In 2011, he founded Christ in the City, a national volunteer and formation program for college students. In 2005, Dr. Reyes helped found the Augustine Institute of Denver, a graduate program devoted to Catholic Theological studies and leadership training and served as its first president.

Dr. Reyes spent several years as a Vice President for the Fellowship of Catholic University Students as well as the Vice President for Academic Affairs at Christendom College where he was a professor of history. He studied European history as a Rackham Fellow at the University of Michigan and earned a PhD in European History at the University of Notre Dame. He and his wife have seven children.
