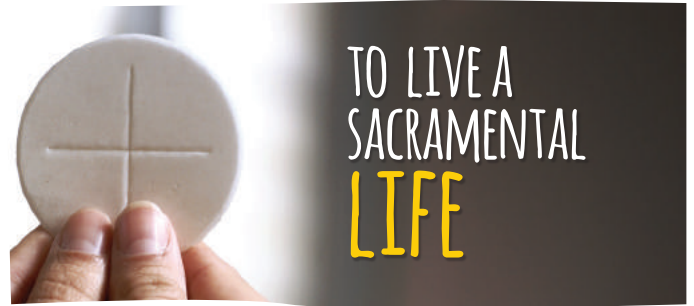

ST. MICHAEL STORY CONTINUED... PART 8

On May 1, 1982, a Spring Dinner Dance was held in St. Michael's new gym. Music provided by Sounds of Swing (Relive the Big Band Era). On May 25, 1982 a reception was held honoring Fr. Lowery. Father served as Associate Pastor of St. Michael since July 7, 1980. His new assignment was Pastor of St. Edward, Granville on June 1, 1982. On November 13, 1982, The St. Michael Women's Club held their annual Bazaar in the new school gymnasium. Visitors to the Bazaar could take part in Crafts made by many parishioners, Secret Santa, Raffle, Baked Goods, White Elephant Sale and more. In December of 1982, parishioner Frank Wallenfels designed and built an outdoor Nativity Scene, so we can all be reminded of the birth of the Savior as they pass St. Michael's during the Christmas season. The Nativity Scene was located for many years in front of Mary's Grotto. Started by Fr. Dinovo a number of years ago, we now have a new Nativity Scene that is erected every Christmas season on the southeast corner of our church property along North High Street.
