

MEN'S FAITH AND FELLOWSHIP STUDY





PARISH HISTORY - DID YOU KNOW?

In 2003, a parish library opened in the St. Michael Room below Marian Hall. Initial Librarians were Michelle Bissonnette, Nick Droll (now Fr. Droll), Alex Jamieson, Annette Petrozzi, Kim Rosmarin, Gina Finley, Mrs. Funk and Alice Heller. The shelves and bookcases were donated by the Knights of Columbus and many parishioners donated books, videos, CDs, and magazines. The Parish Library had religious music (CDs, Audio Tapes), religious children's books, music and videos, religious magazines/periodicals, reference books included the complete collection of the Summa Theologiae from Thomas Aquinas and other wellknown Catholic reference materials. The library was opened after all Masses for parishioners to visit and check out items. During a flood in the lower level of the building shortly after Fr. Dinovo arrived as Pastor, most items were ruined and could not be recovered.


