

PARISH HISTORY

St. Michael Story continued... Part 12

With great anticipation, it was announced that the Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist would be coming to the parish school in August of 2011. St. Ann Hall returned to its original purpose as a convent, which required another expansion to be planned. On September 18, 2012, Fr. Pendolphi was reassigned as priest moderator of St. Aloysius and St. Agnes Parishes, and Fr. Anthony Dinovo was assigned as pastor of St. Michael.

Ground broke on the parish ministry center on March 17, 2013, and it was dedicated and blessed by Bishop Frederick Campbell on November 30, 2013. It added new meeting spaces, offices, a larger Perpetual Adoration Chapel, and a larger space for the St. Vincent de Paul ministry.

From its humble beginnings with its first Mass at the Pontifical College Josephinum, second Mass in a former dance hall on the east end of E. North Street at Pingree Drive, third Mass on the second floor of the Odd Fellows Hall at St. Rt. 161 and Hartford Street, to Masses in the Chase Mansion, then in the Quonset Hut, to our current church, St. Michael the Archangel remains the first and only Catholic parish in the City of Worthington.

SCHOLARSHIP GRANTING ORGANIZATION CERTIFICATION – DIOCESAN EDUCATION CORPORATION

We are happy to announce that the Columbus Diocese's Diocesan Education Corporation has been certified as a Scholarship Granting Organization by the Ohio Attorney General's Office. This certification provides a great opportunity to those who wish to support scholarships/tuition assistance to low-income families hoping to send their children to our Catholic schools. A tax credit is available under section 5747.73 of the Ohio Revised Code for qualified donations to "scholarship granting organizations" (SGOs) certified by the Attorney General. The Diocesan Education Corporation, formed by the Diocese, has obtained the requisite certification to operate as an SGO for calendar year 2022. Under this program, Ohioans can receive a 100% tax credit for up to \$750.00 in cash donations to the Diocesan Education Corporation which grants scholarships to students, including certain private schools and nonprofit organizations. The program aims to prioritize scholarships for low-income students and support parents who seek higher-quality education opportunities for their children.

To qualify for the program, an organization must:

- Be a religious or nonreligious 501(c)(3) exempt from federal taxation.
- Primarily award academic scholarships for primary and secondary students.
- Prioritize scholarships for low-income students.

Accordingly, The Diocesan Education Corporation will repurpose donations received with the intention of primarily awarding academic scholarships for students to attend primary and secondary schools and that these scholarships will prioritize low-income students. Donations in the form of checks should be addressed and made out to the "Diocesan Education Corporation" with the specific intended Diocesan school referenced in the memo line on such check. If this check is received by December 31, 2021, the donor can receive a dollar-for-dollar state of Ohio income tax credit up to \$750.00 for the 2021 tax year. Checks should be mailed to the Office of Catholic Schools, 197 East Gay Street, Columbus, OH 43215. The Diocesan Education Corp. will send all scholarship donors documentation confirming their donation for 2021 tax credit purposes.


