



Last year ended with some challenges, especially for our neighbors to the south in Kentucky and other states with the outbreak of winter tornadoes. Our best weekend for this is going to be next weekend, February 5-6th. If you would like to make a donation, please make your check out to St. Michael Parish and write Tornado Relief on the memo line. There will be a second collection that will be taken up after Communion for this purpose. Funds collected for this will be sent to the Finance Office for the Diocese of Columbus, who will then forward donations to Catholic Charities, USA. Thank you in advance for your generosity.


