





Growing up in a country where the main religion is 95% Muslim, Lucienne grew strong in her Christian faith— learning from both her Grandmother and her Mother. Lucienne had dreams of gaining an education in France but God had different plans for her. Lucienne listened and ended up coming to the United States in 1997 alone and with no family or friends - earning her M.B.A. and eventually becoming a US citizen. Throughout her journey, she has experienced racism, times of darkness, and loneliness but it was always her trust that shone and guided her. Lucienne will share her ministry of S.A.L.T. – as she takes us on her journey from The Gambia where her father sold raw salt for a living - carrying it on his head to take it market miles away - to growing up in a culture where domestic violence is accepted, to immigrating to a new country by herself, then finally "making a deal" with God, to bring the ministry of the Sacred Heart to The Gambia. Lucienne has lived what the Gospel of Matthew describes as " we must be both salt and light..." and Pope Francis says "... salt must add flavor and light must illuminate..." 




