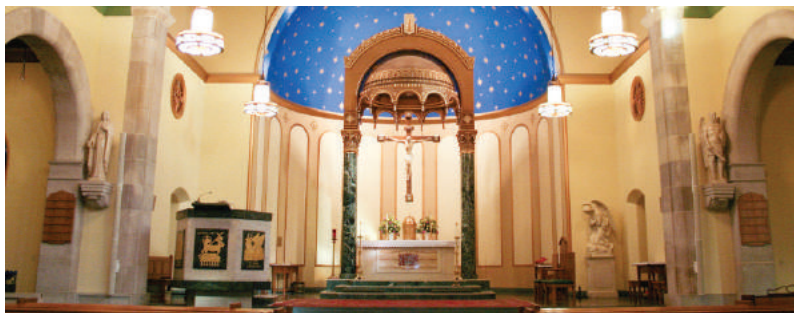
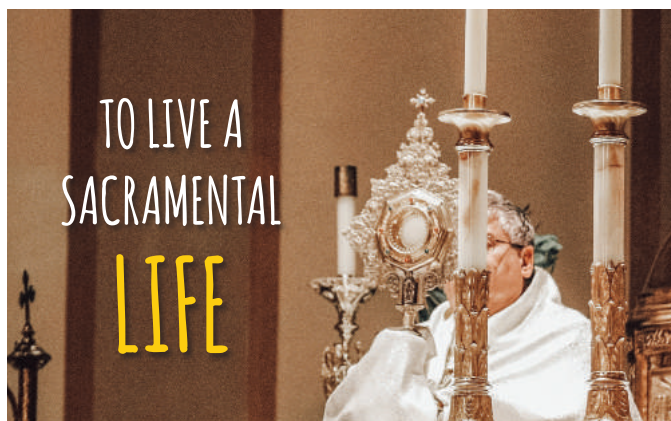

Dear Parishioners,

I want to thank everyone who contributed to the Catholic Relief Services (CRS) special collection the weekend of March 12-13. A total of \$8,956.00 was collected and will be forwarded to CRS through the Diocese of Columbus, as usual. The funds collected will assist in providing safe shelter, hot meals, hygiene supplies, transportation to safe areas, counseling support and more in Ukraine and surrounding bordering countries.

As we do each Lent, you may assist the work of CRS also through "Operation Rice Bowl." Materials are still available in Marian Hall. Money raised for Operation Rice Bowl may be used to help buy seeds so farmers can grow healthy crops; may purchase a lamb for families to provide milk; may purchase fruit trees that produce food and income for farmers and their families; and so much more! Did you know that at least 25% of donations raised through Operation Rice Bowl stays here in our Diocese to support those who are in need?

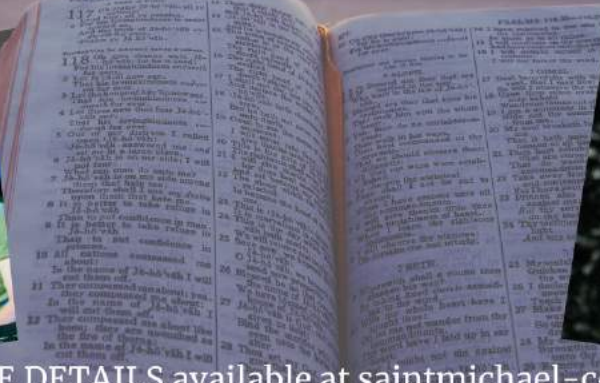

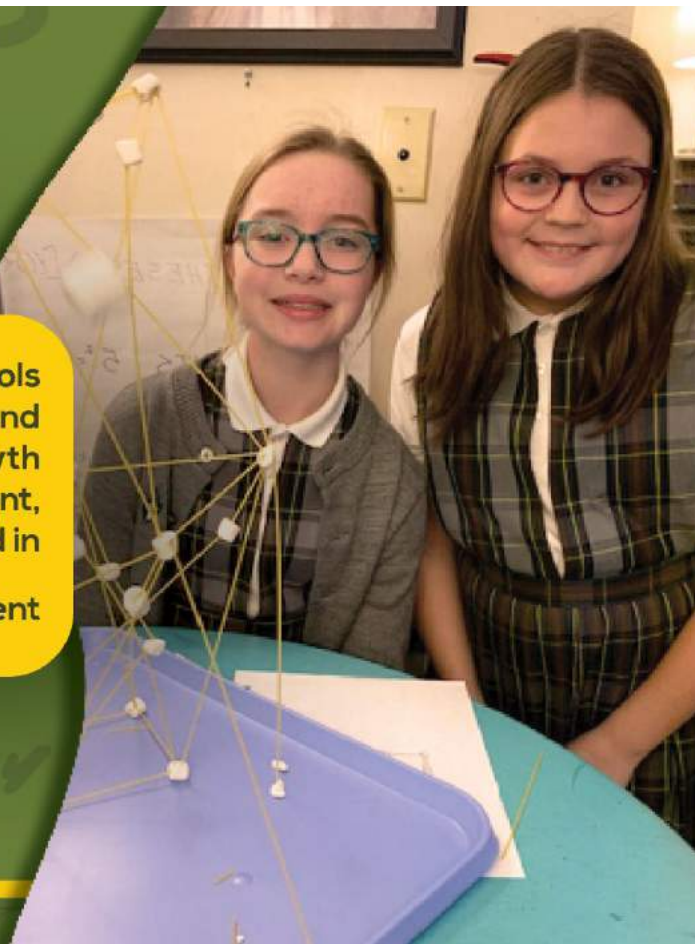
