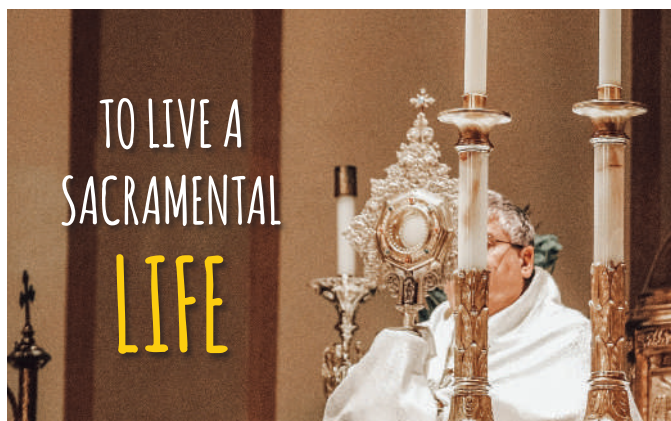

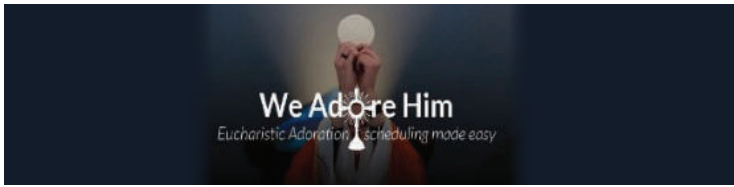
MAY 8, 2022 FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

THE BYZANTINE CATHOLIC CHURCH AND THE UKRAINIAN HERITAGE


