

13th Bishop of Columbus



THE MOST REVEREND EARL K. FERNANDES

Appointed by Pope Francis on April 2, 2022, as the 13th Bishop of the Diocese of Columbus, Reverend Earl K. Fernandes succeeds The Most Reverend Robert J. Brennan, who was installed as the 8th Bishop of Brooklyn on November 21, 2021. Fr. Fernandes, 49, was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, Ohio by the Most Reverend Daniel Pilarczyk on May 18, 2002. He most recently served as the pastor of St. Ignatius of Loyola Church in Cincinnati.

"I look forward to meeting the People of God – the priests, deacons, religious, and lay faithful of the Diocese of Columbus – and to collaborating with them in announcing the joyful Good News and building the Kingdom of God. I ask for your prayers, not only for me but also for our Diocese, that the Holy Spirit may enkindle in all of us the fire of His Divine Love. May God grant me the grace to serve His people well and to be an ardent yet gentle shepherd, whose heart is formed after the Heart of Jesus."


