

## 2022-2023 BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL UPDATE (BAA)

We have gone over our goal!!!! Congratulations and thank you to all who have made their pledges! Our goal set by the Diocese was \$128,903.23. As of the writing of this update our total pledges are \$151,446.00, which means \$22,542.77 so far will come back to us for our own use free of the 6% Diocesan Assessment on income. For the monies that receive this year, we would like to make some much needed improvements and repairs for the Convent building, including the replacement of the roof shingles which have aged quite a bit and are leaking in some areas, as well as replacing the single pane windows throughout the convent with more energy efficient tempered glass windows. 
