

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners

We have gone over our goal for the Bishop's Annual Appeal!!!! Congratulations and thank you to all who have made their pledges! Our goal set by the Diocese was \$128,903.23. As of the writing of this update, our total pledges are \$162,824.00, which means \$33,920.77 so far will come back to us for our own use free of the 6% Diocesan Assessment on income. For the monies that we receive this year, we would like to make some much needed improvements and repairs for the Convent building, including the replacement of the roof shingles which have aged quite a bit and are leaking in some areas, as well as replacing the single pane windows throughout the convent with more energy-efficient tempered glass windows. It is still not too late to give to the BAA. Make your pledge today! Go to our parish website at www.saintmichaelcd.org for more information. Thank you again for your generosity.

This Monday, July 18th, the next phase of the Floor Project will begin and will go for the next couple of weeks. While we do not foresee the need to interrupt the Mass schedule during this time, there will be some interruption in the seating arrangements. Pews will have to be removed from the church in order to replace the tiles below them. We will need to do half of the church at a time. So, when you come to church for Mass, your favorite place to sit may not be there until the project is completed. At this time, the weekday Mass schedule will remain the same and funerals will still be able to be held as needed. However, please note that the church will be closed off during the project working times. If any of this changes, we will let you know.

Parishioners have been inquiring about next year's Religious Education Program. It has been over a year since we have been able to have anything. In that time, I have been actively looking for the right people for the positions needed. While there have been some candidates who have applied, for several reasons the right candidates have not come along. As I have been telling everyone, I have been looking for a "somebody," not just an "anybody." DO YOU NEED A LOW-GLUTEN HOST FOR COMMUNION?

Stop in the Sacristy at least 15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the clergy (If you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an usher, and they'll be happy to assist you).

- Let the clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you need a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- Look for Clergy or an Extraordinary Minister who has a pyx (small cup) attached to their ciborium (the container holding the Hosts). When you approach the minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say, "The Body of Christ" and then will place it in your palm once you respond, "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line as usual.

Life Line Screening goes beyond regular checkups to look inside your arteries for signs of plaque build-up



All 5 Screenings for \$149

Carotid Artery Disease:

An ultrasound is performed to screen the carotid arteries for buildup of fatty plaque.

Peripheral Arterial Disease:

An Ankle-Brachial Index (ABI) test is performed using blood pressure cuffs on the arms and legs.¹

Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm:

An ultrasound is performed to screen the abdominal aorta for the presence of an enlargement or aneurysm.

Atrial Fibrillation:

A 6-lead electrocardiogram (EKG) is performed by placing sensors on the arms and legs to screen for irregular heartbeat.

Osteoporosis Risk:

An ultrasound is performed to measure the shin bone for abnormal bone mass density.

Getting Screened is Simple!

Painless, non-invasive, keep your clothes on.
