

DO YOU NEED A LOW-GLUTEN HOST FOR COMMUNION?

Stop in the Sacristy at least 15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the clergy (if you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an usher, they'll be happy to assist you)

- Let the clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you need a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- Look for Clergy or an Extraordinary Minister who has a pyx (small cup) attached to their ciborium (the container holding the Hosts). When you approach the minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say, "The Body of Christ" and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line as usual.
