

# UPDATE FROM ST. MICHAEL SCHOOL

Dear Parishioners,

We are grateful for all who prayerfully and financially support our young people to give them a Catholic education at St. Michael School.

This school year, St. Michael School is welcoming over 360 students, in PreK through eighth grade. St. Michael PK-8 students belong to 222 families, coming to us from 16 parishes and across 29 zip codes.

Our students are succeeding and are recognized in our Catholic high schools for their academic performance.

#### In the 2021-2022 school year:

- · 62% of St. Michael alumni at DeSales placed on honor roll;
- 51% of St. Michael alumni at Bishop Watterson placed on honor roll; and
- 71% of St. Michael alumni at St. Charles Preparatory School placed on honor roll.

Our Class of 2022 earned academic and character-service recognition scholarships to Catholic high schools totaling over \$113,000. We remain grateful to our Knights of Columbus, SMAA, the Catholic foundation and individual donors who make these scholarships possible.

St. Michael remains committed to helping parents fulfill their vocation to hand down the Faith to their children. Our Catholic school culture includes a weekly All School Mass, Pre K - 6th grade Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, and a K-8 incorporation of the Ruah Woods' Christian Anthropology and theology of the body.

The moral, socio-emotional, and academic formation provided to students centers around encouraging growth in virtue, so our graduates become young adults who make their lives a gift of service to others.

It is our hope that St. Michael School will contribute to forming faithful and life-long Catholics who embrace their vocation to advance in holiness by serving God, their local community and their country. Thank you for your prayers and weekly parish contributions that provide the assistance we need to educate and form the next generation of Catholics in our diocese.


