





It was a gift to have Bishop Fernandes celebrate our All School Mass on our feast day. We are blessed by his care for the people of our diocese and his support for Catholic education.









AND BLESSES TWO PAINTINGS FOR ST. MICHAEL CHURCH

Greg Kucharski (pictured bottom right), a local artist trained in Krakow, Poland, has made two beautiful paintings, customized for St. Michael, with the goal of inspiring people, especially our youth, to draw closer to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Blessed Carlo Acutis is the first millennial saint, known as the patron saint of the internet, and will be particularly relatable for our students.







SAINT MICHAEL

Blessed Carlo Acutis (1991-2006) and St. Pope John Paul II (1920-2005) were chosen to be co-patrons of the next World Youth Day, and are especially important for the Eucharistic Revival. Notice both saints have a monstrance behind them, signifying the strong role the Holy Eucharist played in their spiritual lives, leading them to holiness. The paintings are located near St. Joseph's side altar, at a right corner angle, so that Carlo is looking at the Eucharist, raised for adoration, by the Holy Father who inspired him. Special thanks to the Knights of Columbus and our school families for the donations that provided for these paintings and to Fr. Dinovo for these beautiful additions to our church.


