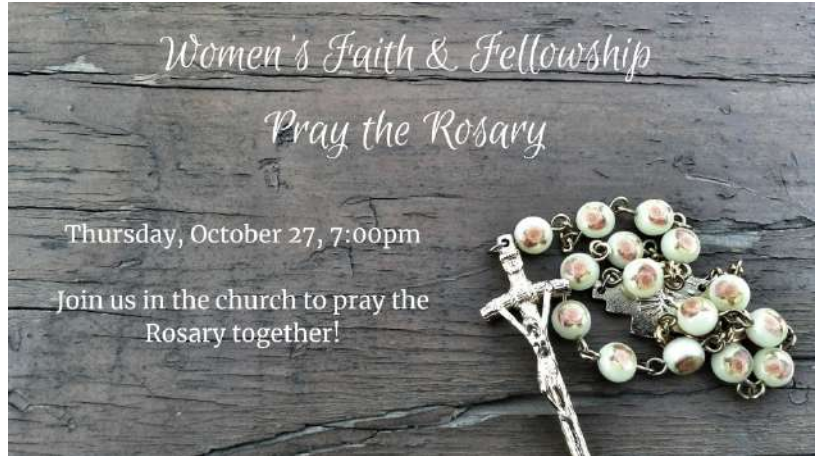


CONGRATULATIONS

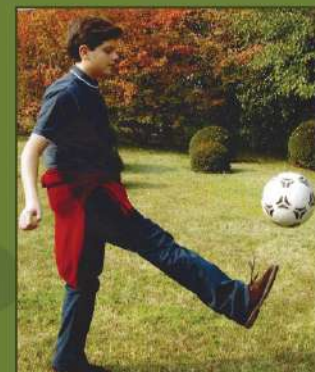


ON OCTOBER 12TH WE CELEBRATE THE FEAST OF BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS



Blessed Carlo Acutis (1991-2006) was known for his purity, moderation, generosity to the poor, and especially his love of the Holy Eucharist. He used his talents with computers, especially coding and programming, to spread the good news about Jesus' loving presence in the Eucharist.
