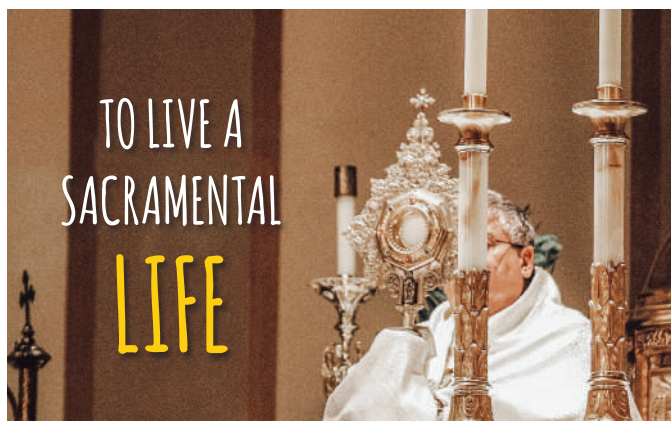

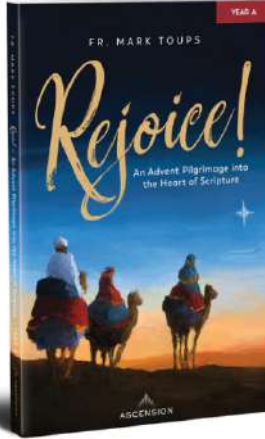
Women's Faith & Fellowship Advent Reflection Journal
