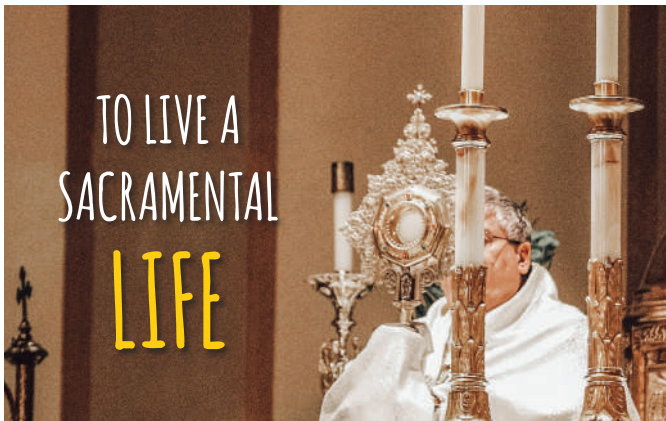

Donors who make a gift to the **Emmaus Road Scholarship**

Fund receive a dollar-for-dollar reduction of their Ohio tax liability upon filing in the next calendar year (equal to the amount of the gift up to \$750 or \$1,500 if married and filing jointly).

NO GIFT IS TOO LARGE OR TOO SMALL, but the Ohio tax credit



is limited to \$750 for an individual and \$1,500 if married and filing jointly.



ANYONE CAN MAKE A GIFT! Parents, grandparents, alumni, friends – anyone with a heart for

making Catholic education accessible and affordable for all. Only Ohio residents will receive the tax credit, but anyone has the potential to realize a Federal tax savings for their contribution.



Gifts made to the general (unrestricted) fund help the greatest number of students in the diocese, starting with low-income families.



DONATIONS POSTMARKED BY DECEMBER 31 will be acknowledged for that tax year.


