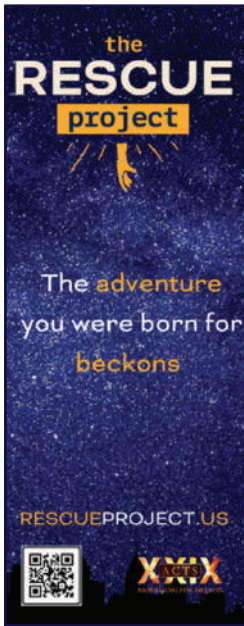


JANUARY 22, 2023 THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

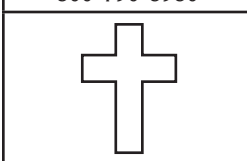

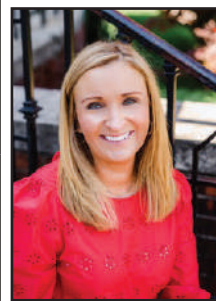
