

SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

In honor of the Feast Day of Our Lady of Lourdes on February 11, after the Sunday Masses on February 11 and 12, the priests of the parish will be available for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick and/or to pray for your health intentions. Those of the Catholic Faithful who are able to receive Holy Communion under normal circumstances and suffer from chronic physical ailments, those preparing for surgery, and the elderly may present themselves for the reception of the Sacrament of Anointing. If anyone does not wish to be anointed but would like to have a priest pray over them, then they may do so by indicating their intention to the priest. A person does not have to be Catholic to have a priest pray over them.

PONTIFICAL COLLEGE JOSEPHINUM GOOD SHEPHERD DINNER HONOREES & KEYNOTE ANNOUNCED


