*"For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven."* – MATTHEW 5:20

### SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

In honor of the Feast Day of Our Lady of Lourdes on February 11, after the Sunday Masses on February 11 and 12, the priests of the parish will be available for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick and/or to pray for your health intentions. 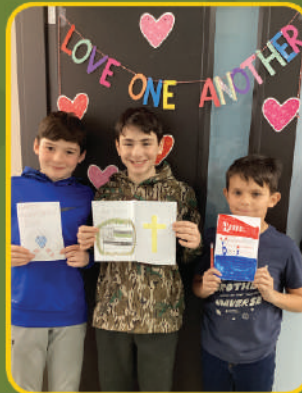

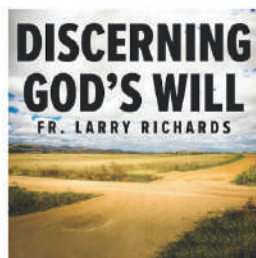

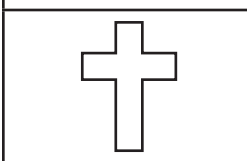
