- April 6, Holy Thursday, after the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper (Mass begins at 7:00pm)
- April 7, Good Friday, after the 3:00pm Good Friday Liturgy and after the Stations of the Cross

FASTING:

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting. The Law of Fasting binds all from the age of 18 through the end of the 59th year. The Law of Fasting prescribes that only one full meal a day be taken. Two lighter meals are permitted but combined should not be more than one full meal.

ABSTINENCE:

Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence. The Law of Abstinence binds all those who have completed their 14th year of age and older. On those days these faithful are not to eat meat.

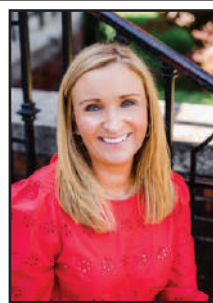
