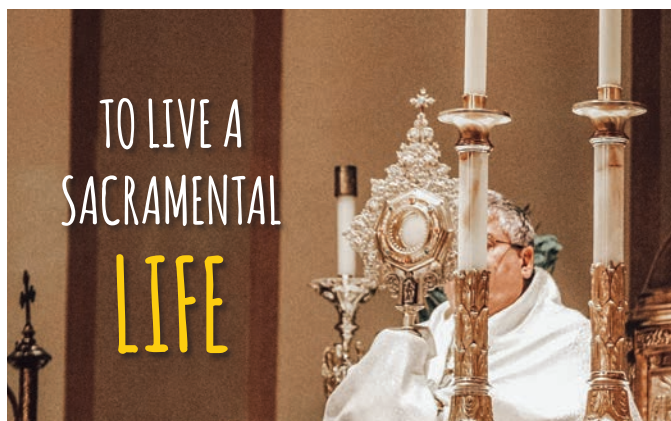

EXTREME ABORTION DOESN'T BELONG IN OUR CONSTITUTION

BACKGROUND

Last summer, the U.S. Supreme Court overturned *Roe vs Wade* and related precedent, returning abortion policy to the states. Currently, Ohio law is that abortion is generally legal until the point of viability, which is presumed at 22 weeks. There are also several laws pending the outcome of litigation, including one that would end most abortions after a baby has a heartbeat. ❤️ ++

A few things to know about Ohio's abortion laws:

- Induced abortion is different than treating or managing a miscarriage (see O.R.C. 2919.11)
- We differentiate between inducing abortions and treating ectopic pregnancies (see ORC 2919.191)
- Ohio law gives doctors wide discretion to take action to protect the life and health of a pregnant woman, even when doing so means that her baby may not survive (see O.R.C. 2919.12, 2919.15, 2919.17, etc.)

By returning the authority to regulate abortion to the states, we have an opportunity to have honest discussions about abortion and decide our own laws through the legislative process, and we can change them if needed.

Abortion advocates are working to stop that discussion by using Ohio's initiated amendment process to change Ohio's Constitution. They want to guarantee a right to "Reproductive Freedom" without any government interference. *This would apply not only to abortion, but to an expanded list of anything deemed to be a reproductive right—including sterilization, fertility treatment, and gender-identity related medical procedures. Reading it closely shows that it would actually prohibit any action by any level of state or local government that would be a "direct or indirect burden" to obtaining or providing services in these areas.*

If by July 5th they gather valid signatures from about 415,000 Ohio voters in at least 44 counties this will be on the November 2023 ballot. This proposal is dishonest and extreme, and if it is amended into Ohio's Constitution the only way it will be changed is to raise millions of dollars to amend the Constitution—again and again. If you are asked - **decline to sign**, and get others to join you.

GET INVOLVED

1. **Pray and Fast:** The Catholic Bishops of Ohio have invited the faithful to join them in this prayer throughout the campaign.
2. **Learn more:** Skeptical of what we are saying? That is ok. Go to our website and read their language yourself. Review the analysis that we provide. Read what the proponents are saying in their own words. Then help us by getting involved and downloading resources.
3. **Get Involved:** Our "Decline to Sign" campaign is starting now. We will also be hosting town halls, meetings, and other small group events to talk about this issue. Go on our website to get signed up, or invite us to speak to your group.
4. **Donate:** Our opponents have millions of dollars from special interests and those who profit from abortion. We have you. We need your help to continue our ongoing work while mobilizing to defeat this ballot initiative. Visit: gcrtl.org/donate to support us.

AT A GLANCE THIS WOULD...

- **Repeal** abortion laws, including those that prohibit painful and cruel abortions later in pregnancy, even on perfectly healthy babies.
- **Eliminate** requirements that parents be involved and notified (or that an alternate judicial process be followed) before children are taken for abortion, sterilization, or gender-related treatment.
- **Risk** religious freedom and conscience protections on any matter determined to fall under the broad umbrella of "reproductive care."

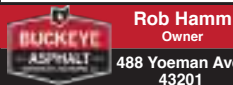
