Dear members of our St. Michael School community,

As a result, Sr. Mary Regina will carry on the work we are doing at St. Michael. We have an admirable team of faculty and staff, who work together with charity and professionalism, to achieve a shared success. While we have room to grow, our vision forward will continue the work we have begun, in the same direction, with increasing excellence. I will be actively working with Sister for a smooth transition of leadership, made easier as I will still reside at St. Michael.
