


JOIN ST. ANN'S ALTAR SOCIETY AND HELP KEEP OUR CHURCH CLEAN!

AROUND THE DIOCESE

AUGUST SPECIAL ELECTION

A special election will take place in Ohio on August 8, 2023 to vote on Issue 1, which asks voters if Ohio should "Require that any proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Ohio receive the approval of at least 60 percent of eligible voters voting on the proposed amendment." As our bishops remind us, "In the Catholic Tradition, responsible citizenship is a virtue, and participation in political life is a moral obligation" (Faithful Citizenship, No. 13). We urge you to register and vote in the upcoming election:

- July 10: Deadline to Register to Vote or Update Voter Information
- July 11-August 6: Absentee and Early In-person Voting
- Tuesday, August 8: ELECTION DAY

Please note: The bishops of Ohio do not have a position on Issue 1 in August, as raising the threshold to amend the Ohio Constitution does not have any direct moral content. This is different than the proposed November 2023 ballot initiative which would expand and enshrine abortion which the Ohio bishops oppose. The Catholic Conference of Ohio is the official voice of the Catholic Church in Ohio on public policy, advocating for the dignity of life at all stages, immigrants, Ohioans in need, and Catholic education.




