#### **2. Pastor Report**

- The Finance Council met last night - this weekend we are launching the Appeal and our diocesan goal is \$148K, but to cover past debt, our St. Michael goal or our enhanced goal is going to be \$500K, diocesan tax, it is helpful when people choose to use the electronic deposit for collection.
- Kris and Steve have been working on a list of maintenance projects for the summer, working with buildings and grounds diocesan reps to walk the property and establish a program maintenance plan going forward.
- We have been busy with sacrament prep, including an 8th grade retreat. 1st Communion will be held during the 4pm Saturday evening Mass on May 4, and Confirmation with the Bishop will be held during the 4pm Saturday evening Mass on May 11.

#### **3. Chairperson Report**

- Thank you for help during Lent/Easter
- We will be starting to grill and set up for the Memorial Day event around 9 to be able to wrap and serve hot dogs starting at 10. All help will be appreciated and thanks to the KofC for grilling and paying for the hot dogs and buns.
- We will be canceling the May meeting due to the Memorial Day holiday. Our next meeting will be June 25 at 7pm.

#### **4. Standing Member Reports**

- Sr. Mary Regina gave an update on the upcoming events, including Confirmation retreat for 8th graders, 7th grade Science Fair May 3, All school May Crowning on May 10, Art Show in the Gym on May 17, Spring Musical on May 23, 8th grade Graduation on May 29, last day of school is may 31.
- She expressed gratitude for the parish members who contributed to the Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund; this year we raised 115K up from 80K last year.

- Kris Jesse reported that she is working with Steve on building a summer punch list for projects for this upcoming summer in addition to building a 3, 5, and 10-year plan for maintenance projects.
- Rebecca Lunch reported that she is finishing all of the website updates and just has a few more pages to update.

#### **5. Appointed Member Reports**

- Adoration is going well. During the last Candlelight event and at recent Friendship Sunday, there were cards distributed to encourage people to sign up for an Adoration hour. They are considering bringing back Wednesday hours after the festival.
- Athletic Association (see attached report)
- Boy Scouts will be placing flags at Greenlawn Cemetery, marching in the Memorial Day Parade, placing flags for veterans at the VFW, and will be at Resurrection Cemetery for the flag raising. They are going to try to do a Catholic camporee in May.
- Festival committee is happy with the back layout of the festival at this point and they are looking to take advantage of the front lawn to create a large area of inflatables and kid games. The vendor they are considering will come with people to work the games and inflatables. They are researching fencing options to make sure it is fun and safe for everyone. There are plans in place to bring back the paper raffle tickets in addition to making the raffle part of the online silent auction bidding app.
- Knights of Columbus held another successful pancake breakfast last weekend. They will be participating in the measure up campaign on May 4, a social event at the Josephinum and will be helping place flags at Resurrection Cemetery on May 25.
- Women's Faith and Fellowship is still holding weekly Pietra classes, including mother-daughter classes. The last Candlelight event was a success with 10 full tables and great positive feedback for Monica Richards presentation. They are continuing to run morning book study, with 25 women currently. They will be starting to sponsor pilgrimages. On the future radar are Vacation Bible School and Mom's Day Out during the school year.

#### Finance

Liz reviewed the SMAA waiving the fee of coaches (head vs. head/assistant) as part of their return for coaching. During a meeting with Kris, Jesse said this is a diocese process. St. Mary's completed this for their coaches, which was positive for the community.

- The meeting attendees discussed this, and we will pilot the waiving of the fees for the Fall sports for the head coach for those teams (Cross Country, Soccer, Football, and Volleyball)
- This summer, we will create a document explaining this process to the SMAA community.
- This Academic Year, we will also be instituting a review of all our coaches for the year for the parents to fill out in May. This will allow us to track the coaches' and parents' feedback. Liz will create this evaluation to be sent out to the families.

#### Spring Sports

Baseball, Softball, and Track are all up and running. We have provided the CYO with feedback about Doodlio and growth opportunities, as the merger was an issue.

#### St. Peter

Liz met with Kris Jesse, and she is working on an MOU with St. Peter's regarding the field and potential gym usage. Kris will provide an update when available.

With the MOU, we will invest funds at St. Peter to fix the field and support spaces (garage doors, bleachers, dugouts, etc.). We are getting a quote for the upgrade in the field and drainage and will bring that back to the group for discussion and approval.

#### St. Michael Field

Because St. Peter is booked almost all season for games, Adam Rohrer and Steve Moore will work to drag the St. Michael field so that the kids can get fielding in for practice times this season.

#### Fellowship

The Ministry Fair was a success and was well received. Thank you to those who volunteered at the table.
