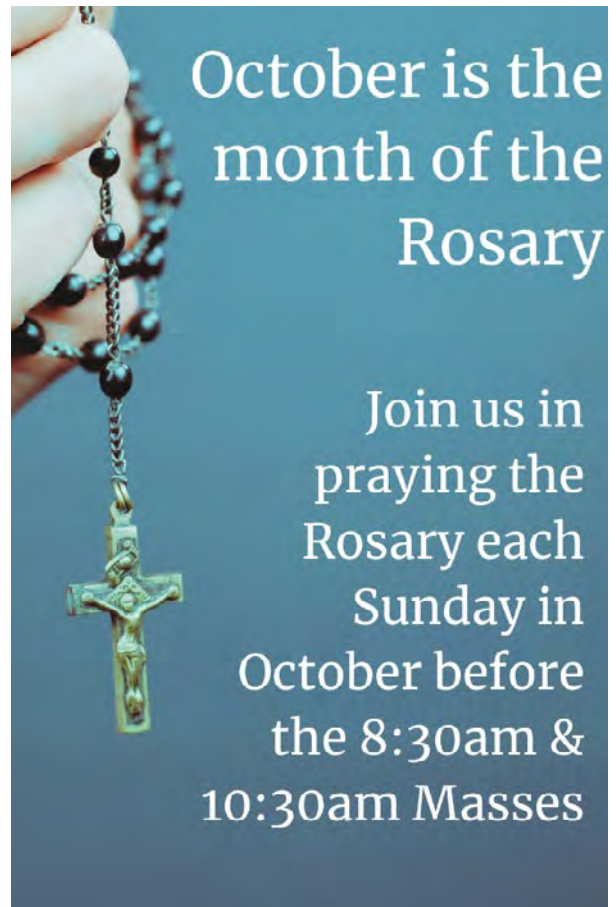

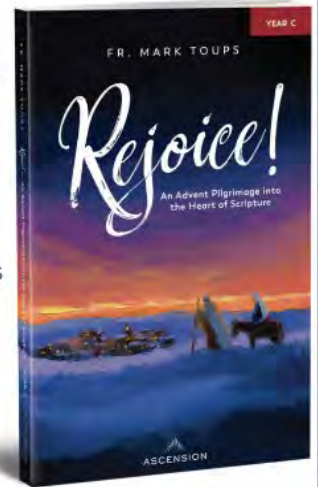
BOY SCOUT WREATH SALE
