As we enter into the final stretch of Lent, we now experience the veiled glory. Literally, our statues are now veiled thus reminding us that we each have those moments where the presence is there but not seen. We are deprived of some beauty and some sense of consolation inviting us to realize the gravity of recalling the message of Jesus and what He lived in the moments leading up to the Passion.

AROUND THE PARISH

LENTEN FAMILY HOLY HOUR AND CONFESSIONS

Our parish's Lenten Family Holy Hour with Confessions will be offered on Wednesday, March 25th following the 6:00 p.m. Holy Mass. We will have multiple priests available to assist with Confessions while the Lord is enthroned for Adoration on the altar.

ST. MICHAEL CAMPUS UPDATES

Last year's Annual Appeal for the Diocese was not only met but significantly surpassed allowing our parish to invest in our future. Our parish family was able to make a sizeable increase to our Endowment Fund at the Catholic Foundation of \$50,000.00.

In addition to that "pay it forward" portion of our fundraising which increased our Endowment Fund, we have also been able to address many areas of maintenance needing attention.

We are in the process of planning the replacement of the kneeler cushions in the pews. We are working with local contractors on options for new doors for the entrance of the church.

We have been able to pay for the complete replacement of all security cameras in the Marian Hall and Parish Office portion of the parish building.

We have been able to address a long-lasting leak in the main cast iron drain in the rectory which had led to a major mold problem within the walls of the rectory kitchen. To be honest, no one knew this problem even existed until we set out to renew the kitchen with updates.

We are addressing another long-lasting issue of mold in the convent. Every radiator in the convent was found to have a design flaw which has made each of them susceptible to a major mold colony. Plans are underway to address this issue. Building on last year's improvements to new windows and removal of all carpets, we are working hard to make sure our sisters have a safe, healthy, and comfortable living space.

A change in the parish campus surrounding the convent has been undertaken for the enhancement of security as well as an increase in protection for our students while school is in session. These changes will also create a private outdoor area for the sisters to be able to enjoy when the weather is nice.

The flat roof of Marian Hall is at present under review for a replacement and we are in the process of collecting bids for this job to be finished once the weather has improved. This project will address the leaks in the women's restroom as well as the leaks in Marian Hall's kitchenette and hallways.

All of the above projects are either already completed or underway as a result of our parish family's generous response to last year's Annual Appeal.



CONFRATERNITY OF THE MOST HOLY ROSARY

St. Michael the Archangel parish is blessed to begin the process of erecting a local Confraternity of the Holy Rosary. The Provincial of the Dominican Friars of St. Joseph Province has been petitioned to bless the request for a Confraternity in our parish. Once this blessing has been given and our local Bishop acknowledges the Provincial's blessing, a date of decree will be established.

The Confraternity is open to any adult Catholic, having already received all Sacraments of Initiation, who desires to avail themselves to the good works and graces associated with the Confraternity. There is a commitment of praying all 15 traditional Mysteries of the Rosary every week. Members are expected to be mindful of all other members of the Confraternity around the world who are also praying, thus engaging in an act of spiritual solidarity.

Our local Confraternity will take upon itself a Spiritual Work of Mercy and a Corporal Work of Mercy by leading the public recitation of the Holy Rosary before one Sunday Mass as well as gather at a local nursing home once a month to lead the Rosary with interested residents.

Enrollments in the local Confraternity will take place in May and October. This May, we will welcome Fr. Stephen Dominic Hayes, OP to St. Michael to preach our Marian Triduum beginning on Mother's Day Weekend. He will guide our parish through the power of the Holy Rosary and help us initiate the local Confraternity.

More information to come as developments occur.
